The Boyd Family Farm is located in the Deerfield Valley and only minutes from Wilmington Center. Owned and operated by the same family for over 80 years, Boyd Farm offers three seasonal collections. In the summer, pick your own flowers and blueberries, and an extensive array of perennials and annuals. In the fall, collections of Mums, Kale & Cabbage, Pumpkins and Gourds. During the winter season they have an extensive collection of centerpieces, wreaths of all sizes, kissing balls and swags. Their specialty is weddings.



The barn has a new roof, foundation and slab with radiant heat and farm market. The attached storage and walk in cooler rooms are operational and almost complete. They have a clean weather tight area set aside for washing and drying produce. Room is sheet rocked and they purchased the waterproof kitchen wall panels, still need to insulate the ceiling and install commercial plumbing - kitchen sinks have been purchased. The handicap bathroom is ready for plumbers, electricians and fixtures. Office area needs metal roofing, GFI beams, insulation, exterior door, sheetrock on the ceiling and interior walls. They have insulated the north walls in the equipment bays of the barn with spray foam and need to get pressboard for wall and ceiling coverage, insulation for the ceiling and store side wall.
