The hardworking honey bees that gather the nectar to produce Dancing Bee Honey are not exposed to toxic synthetic chemicals and antibiotics to control parasitic mites and diseases. The use of nontoxic organic methods helps to ensure the purity and superior quality of the honey harvested. This special care makes Dancing Bee honey ideal for use as both a food and for apitherapy.



Dancing Bee Gardens project is a one-and-one half story building for use in honey production, beekeeping courses and small scale mushroom growing. It will be of standard stick-built construction with a 20' x 28' footprint and 10' high walls. The roof will be of asphalt-shingle Dutch gambrel design. It will sit upon a base of crushed marble, with low, frost-protected, fieldstone/cement walls bearing the weight of the structure. A stairway will access the upper level.
