The Intervale Center and partners will implement their impactful land access programming, providing in depth services and mini-coaching sessions to a total of 25 farmland seekers while strengthening Vermont Land Link. With the average age of a Vermont farmer at 57, we know a significant amount of land will change hands in the next decade. In this project, the Intervale Center will provide technical assistance and resources to land seekers so that they are better prepared and more suitably matched to land opportunities, furthering the Working Lands` mission to grow the economies, cultures, and communities of Vermont`s working landscape. By ensuring farmers are matched with suitable land, this project will help the entire supply chain grow. When new businesses thrive on underutilized parcels, they bring back local food production, community and rural life. Farmers buy supplies, hire labor, and engage neighbors. They keep our landscape beautiful and working.
