Vermont Farm and Forest Viability Program (VFFVP) will use working lands funds to provide forestry sector entrepreneurs with in-depth, one-on-one business advising in: strategic planning, marketing and sales, financial record-keeping and analysis, feasibility analysis, human resources, production efficiencies and succession planning. They prioritize enrolling businesses that provide critical infrastructure to the future of the forest products industry, particularly mills, innovative forest products enterprises, and young loggers. VFFVP is in its third year of serving forestry and forest-products enterprises through a new network of forestry sector business advising programs.
