

Meeting Place Pastures

Cornwall, VT



Meeting Place Pastures is a husband and wife partnership operating on approximately 250 acres in Cornwall, Vt. Their main farmstead is a 97 acre tract on Clark Road, where they graze and house their cows, pigs and chickens. They own and rent parcels on West Street (total of 95 acres) and rent 65 acres on Route 30. Mark and Cheryl direct market grass-fed/finished beef, pasture-raised pork, and organic eggs at the Burlington farmers' market, through local and regional vegetable CSA farms, a handful of restaurants, and at their farm stand. They have been operating since 2009.



Funding would allow them to expand their custom grazing enterprise, providing a service of grazing other producers' livestock in a management-intensive system. Funds would be used for grazing infrastructure and forage and fertility improvements, including high tensile and temporary fence, a water system, an energizer, clover seed and chicken manure.
