

Based on the limited WLEI funds, these grants were able to be sponsored by the Dairy Business Innovation Center, which targets value-added processors to work with professional firms for marketing and branding.



In response to the ongoing challenges that COVID-19 presents to Vermont's working lands businesses, the Working Lands Enterprise Board (WLEB) announced 16 businesses who have received over \$250,000 in COVID-19 Response Business Development Grants within the sectors of agriculture and forestry.


